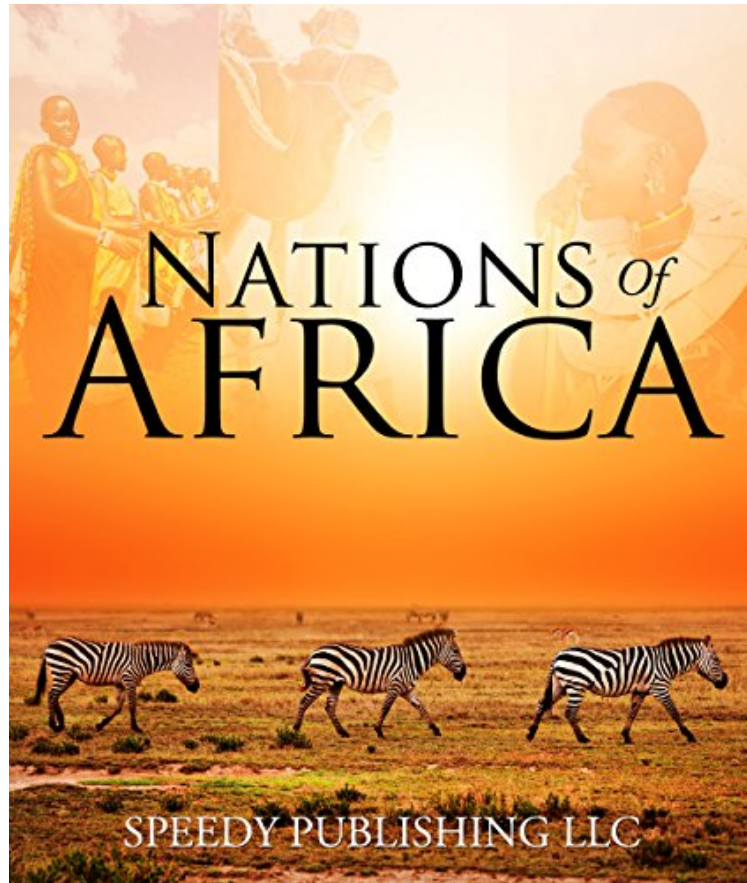

The photographs are stunning - clear, crisp, interesting - I was very excited to explore the book. But I was soon disappointed. None of the photographs are captioned. If a person is photographed in 'tribal dress/clothing'; - what tribe or group is represented? I think it would be helpful/informative to know. There is one photograph of a man with a very enlarged (plate-sized) lip. What child (or adult) is 'not going to ask how that happened? The photographs of animals are easily recognizable, but I would still like a caption. Where does this animal live in Africa? The book was a series of stunning photographs (which were not captioned or seemed to have any order or purpose) interspersed with 'facts' that were not illustrated or explained in any way. For example, Africa is a continent. Show me a globe or map with Africa highlighted. Otherwise that fact means nothing to me. I want maps that show me the Serengeti; Lake Malawi; Cairo; the Sahara Desert. The vocabulary words were not appropriate to a picture book audience. de facto independent states (means what?) Pharaonic Civilization (means what?) hominidae
