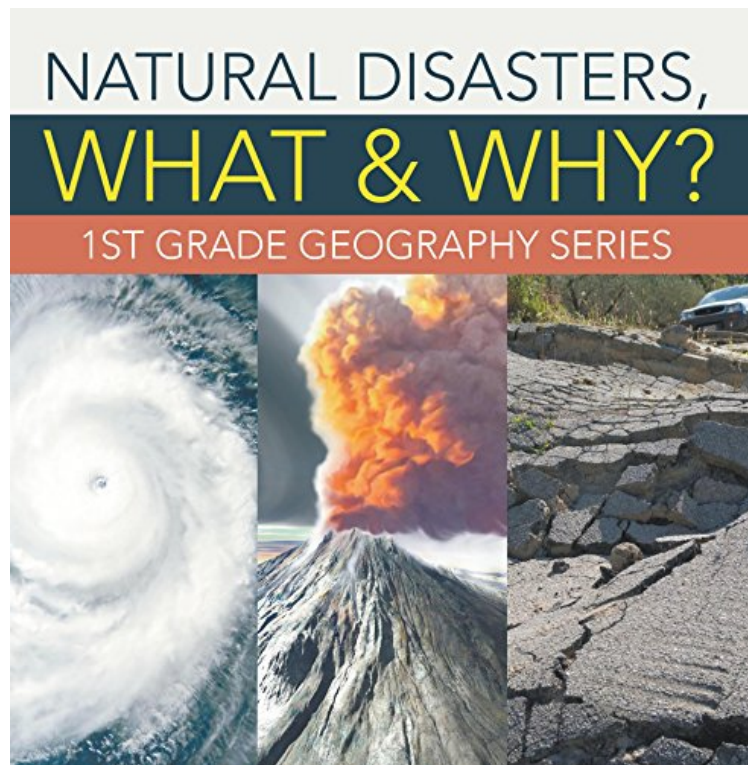

One particular page shows what looks like an entire community about to be washed away by a giant tsunami wave (possibly even two waves).
