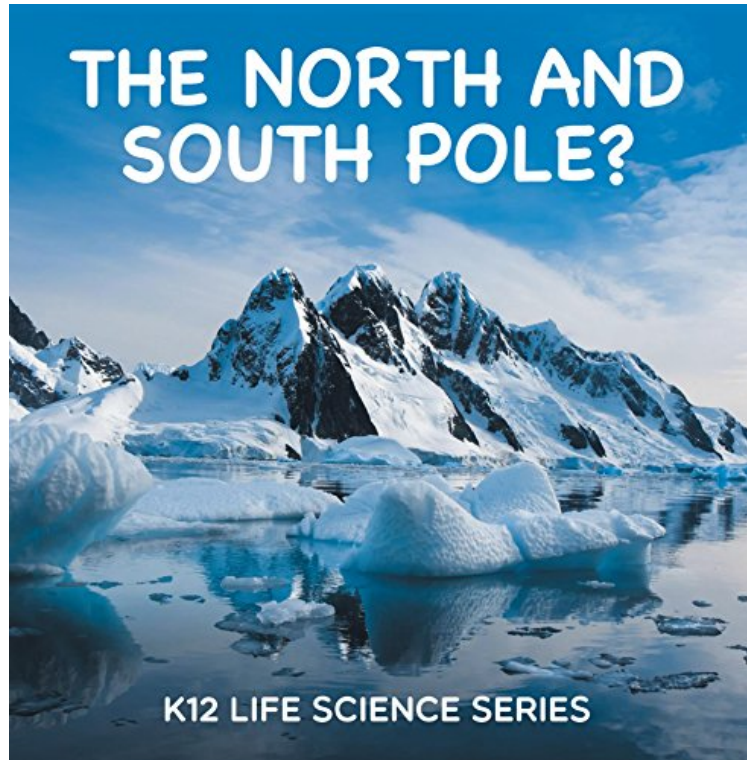

The older kids have read and seen documentaries on a lot of this material so they were not impressed. If your kids are not at all familiar with these areas or geography in general there may be something useful here for them. Some of the pictures were really nice. One that did not make sense was one supposedly taken at the north pole where there is no land, only ice. There is a road in a wooded area with a mail box. The last time I studied botany I don't remember any trees that grow in ice. Either they are wrong about there being no land, or wrong about where the picture was taken or something!
