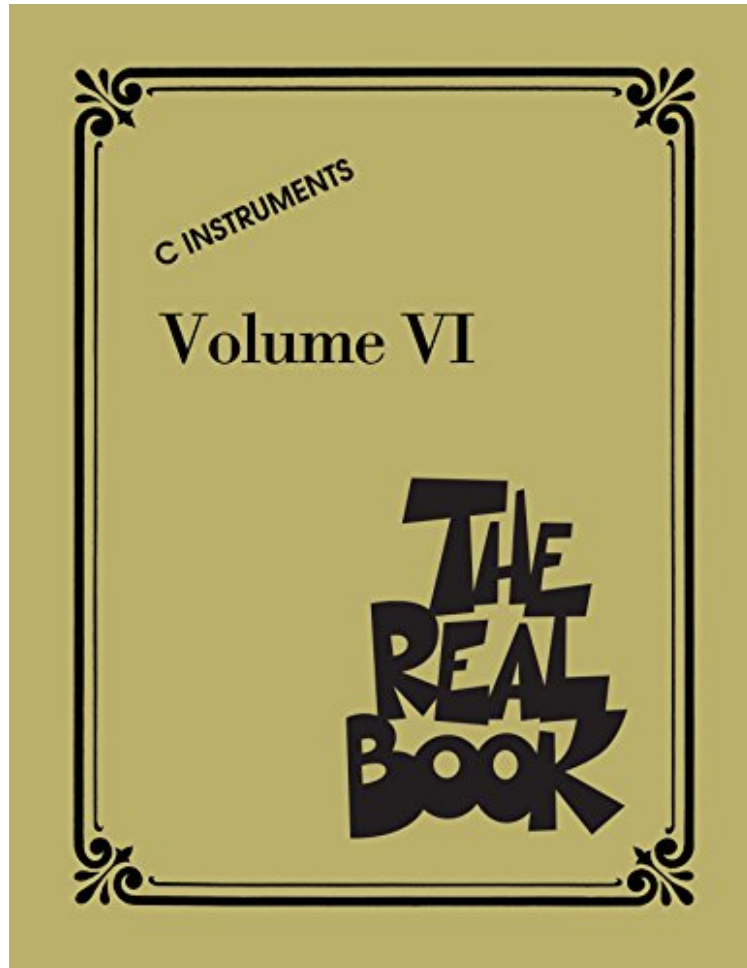

Unlike Volumes 1 through 5, Volume 6 on Kindle Cloud Reader does NOT have links in the table of contents that go directly to the songs..The songs in volume 6 are excellent and complement

nicely the songs in the first 5 volumes I went to the Hal Leonard website and reported this problem on August 6, 2017. A few days later a Hal Leonard customer support representative forwarded my problem report to their digital team. The digital team wrote back to say they did not consider this to be a problem. They conceded the links do not work on Kindle Cloud Reader, but pointed out the links on Volume VI work on iPad and iPhone They wrote that it was hard for them to test the links in the Kindle Cloud Reader.
