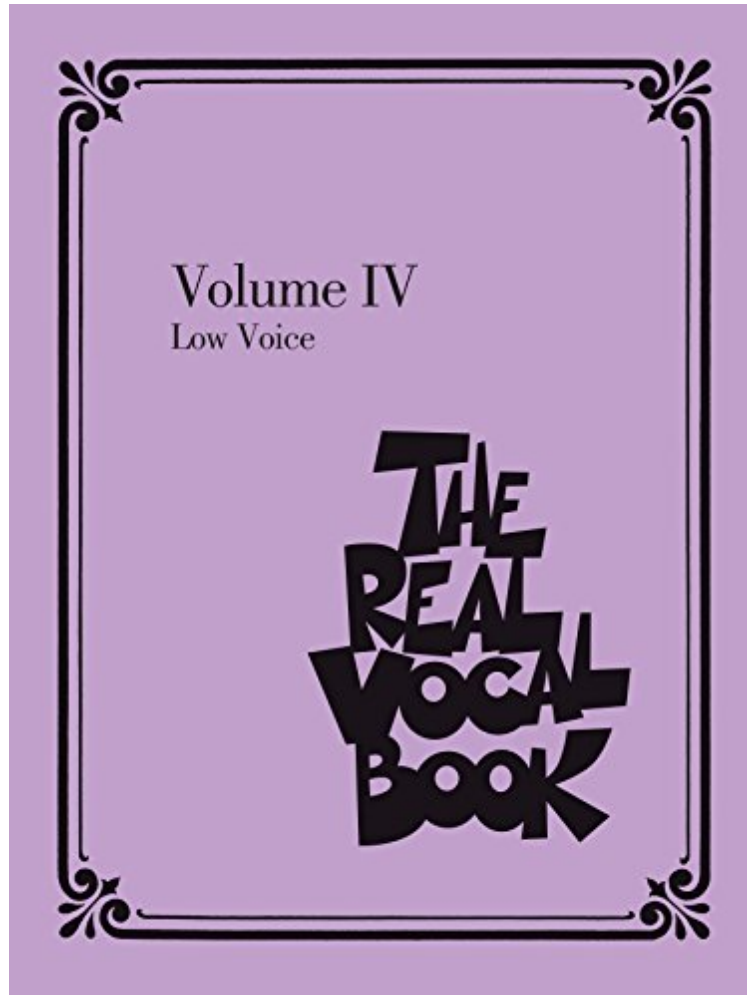

ALREADY!!!! The contents are actually the High Voice version. I think they made a publishing mistake. I have all the Volumes and this is the only volume where both high and low versions are in the same key. To compare that this isn't something they meant to do, look at the iTunes sample version and you'll see that "About A Quarter to Nine" is in C in the high version and the low voice version is in Bb. However, in this low voice Kindle version, "About A Quarter to Nine" is in the key of C, which is the same as the High Voice version. Please fix this or Hal Leonard!!!!
