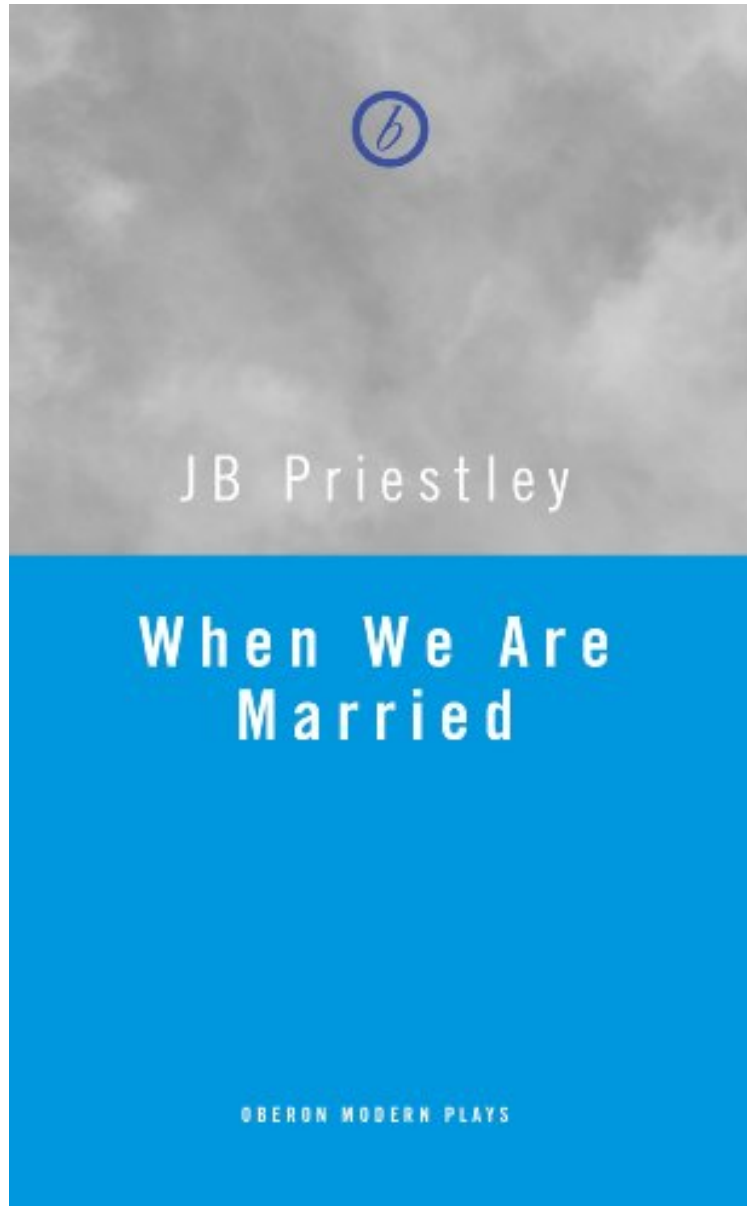

About the Author John Boynton Priestley he gained a degree from Cambridge University after fighting in the infantry in World War I. He wrote successful articles and essays, then published the first of many novels, *The Good Companions*. After first play, *Dangerous Corner*, he went on to write 50 more, including *Time and the Conways*, *I Have Been There Before*, *When We Are Married*, and *An Inspector Calls*.
